SOLO EXHIBITION REVIEW

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all resident Alaska visual artists who have not had a solo exhibition at the Alaska State Museum (ASM) within the past six years.

MEDIA

Original work in any media.

SUBMISSION

Application should include:

- Ten (10) 35 mm. slides. Slides should be of high-quality and reflect the type of work you wish to exhibit. No original pieces of art will be accepted. Slides should be submitted in a plastic sheet. Slides should be labeled with a number, the artist's name, and title of the work. Top of work should be indicated with an arrow. We recommend that you do not send your only copy of a slide.
- A CD of the work is an acceptable substitute for the 35mm slides. Please make sure the images are at least 300 dpi as they will be projected for viewing.
- A list, with the applicant's name and address, slide/disc number, title, medium, size of work, date of creation and an exhibition history of the applicant must accompany all submissions.
- Completed application form and exhibit proposal.
- If you wish to have the slides / disc returned after review, you **must include** a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- The Alaska State Museum maintains a slide / disc bank of contemporary Alaska artists. If you wish to have your material added to this bank, check this box on the application form.

Accepted artist solo exhibitions will be announced

ACCEPTANCE

Exhibitions will be for a period of approximately one month, and will be scheduled at a time mutually agreed upon by the Curator of Exhibitions and the artist.

The Museum takes no commission on gallery sales; parties interested in sales must contact the artist or owner of the work directly.

Upon acceptance, **the artist** will be responsible for:

- Transporting the exhibition to the ASM. If the exhibit is hand-delivered, the artist is also responsible for picking up their exhibit at the close of the exhibition by a previously agreed upon date. Work left beyond that date is not the responsibility of the ASM.
- The artist must supply the ASM with text for exhibit labels, an artist's statement and up to 100 mailing labels for exhibition announcements. Dates to be agreed upon with the Museum Curator.
- The artist must supply the ASM with a high quality transparency or electronic file of a selected work to be used for an exhibition announcement image and publicity purposes, by an agreed upon date.
- The artist must supply the ASM with a price list or insurance value for all works in the exhibition.

Upon acceptance, **ASM** will be responsible for:

- Publicity for the solo artist exhibition, including press releases and exhibition announcements. This announcement will be sent to the museum's mailing list and up to 100 additional addresses provided by the artist.
- Installation of the exhibition.
- ASM and the Friends of the Alaska State Museum will host an opening reception for the exhibit.
- Artwork will be insured by the ASM while on the premises and during return shipment.
- ASM will pack and return exhibit materials following the close of the exhibition.
